NEW JERSEY

- **Legislation**

- On May 23, 2018, Governor Phil Murphy signed into law a key energy bill that requires 35% of New Jersey's power to come from renewables by 2025, and 50% by 2030. In addition, the law establishes the most ambitious solar-specific target in the nation — requiring utilities source 5% of their energy from distributed solar by 2021. In addition, he signed an executive order for New Jersey to develop a plan to reach 100% clean energy by 2050.
