

# STATE-BY-STATE GREEN ENERGY UPDATES

## VIRGINIA

- **Legislation**

- In March 2018, Virginia passed the Grid Transformation & Security Act of 2018, which states 5,000 Megawatts of solar development by utilities is in the interest of the state. In October, Dominion Virginia Power issued an RFP (Request for Proposal) for 500 Megawatts of solar projects, to be developed by 2020. The projects may either be sold to Dominion or it will purchase the energy they produce through 20-year power purchase agreements. The resulting solar development will be utility-scale, with the minimum allowable project size being 5 MW.
